

Scheduling the start-up and shutdown of your Sedao V3 Player


As with any Windows based computer, powering on and off of the device can be controlled by a couple of simple system settings:

1. Scheduling a system power on time.


The system power on timer can be access via the system Bios settings. You can get to these settings by tapping the delete key as you turn the device on.

If done correctly, you be presented with the blue and grey system bios screen; you can navigate around the settings on this screen using the arrow keys on your keyboard any by hitting the enter key on any settings you wish to change.

The first step to setting the power on is to navigate to the advanced tab and then select the 'Power Management Configuration' option:




On the next screen you want to select the 'PowerOn by RTC Alarm' setting:



And then on the screen that pops up select 'Enable'

Once done you'll be presented with a series of additional options for you to schedule the power on time and the days that the power on will occur, in the example below I've set a power on schedule for 7:30 during the week:



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
Once the RTC alarm has been set you simply need to scroll across to the 'Exit' tab and select 'Save Changes and Exit'.

With the RTC alarm set you're ready to setup the automatic shutdown.


2. Scheduling a system shutdown

The shutdown task is setup using the Windows Task Scheduler, rather than the system Bios. To set up shutdown schedule using a Task Scheduler do the following:


1. Start Task Scheduler. You can start it by going to the Start Menu typing schedule in the Search bar and choosing Schedule tasks.
2. When Task Scheduler opens click the Create Basic Task.




3. Enter the name for your task, for example Shutdown.




4. Now choose When do you want the task to start, for a repeating schedule select 'Daily'




5. Now enter the time and date when the task will be executed.




6. Next choose Start a program.




- Click the Browse button and go to C:\Windows\System32 and select a file called shutdown. Then click Open.



- Now just in Add arguments field add -s, and then click Next.



- Now you should see the task information. You can check it one last time, and if you're pleased with your settings click Finish to schedule a shutdown.



That's it, with both the shutdown and power on tasks set you're Sedao V3 Player will now automate its daily schedule.
